## PROTEST PROCEDURE

1. The nature of the protest must be communicated to Site Director immediately following the conclusion of the game.
2. The Site Director will communicate the potential protest to the lead referee on site or head referee.
3. The head/lead referee determines if the issue qualifies as a protest.
4. If it is determined that the issue may be protested, the protestor must submit a \$100 *cash* filing fee and a Protest Form to the Site Director within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the game.
5. The lead referee will notify the opposing team's coach of the protest.
6. The Site Director will notify the Tournament Director of the protest, so the Championship Finals Management Committee may convene. Only if the filing fee and Protest Form are received within 30 minutes of the game's conclusion, will there be a hearing.
7. There will be a final determination by the CFMC as soon as possible following the protest being filed. The CFMC can meet by conference call. The Protestor will be notified of the decision by a head referee, which will communicate its decision to the Protester and, if necessary, the opposing team.
